**AN ORDINANCE  
TO AMEND  
CHAPTER 6  
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD  
ENTITLED  
"Administration of Government"**

*"Interpretive Statement"*

*This ordinance will revise the table of organization of the Maplewood Police Department.*

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, the Table of Organization of the Maplewood Police Department is reviewed and revised; and

**WHEREAS**, the Maplewood Police Chief has recommended a change in the Maplewood Police Department Table of Organization to add an additional police Captain.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that:

**FIRST:** The Maplewood Police Department Table of Organization be amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created in and for the Township of Maplewood, a Police Department, which shall consist of a Chief of Police, not more than three (3) Captains, not more than five (5) Lieutenants, not more than ten (10) Sergeants, and such number of Patrol Officers as are deemed to be necessary by the Maplewood Township Committee from time to time.\*

**SECOND: Severability**

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

\*Section 6-29 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Police Department" shall be so amended:

**THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances**

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

**FOURTH: Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on February 21, 2017, and that Committee met again on March 7, 2017, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
