AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CERTAIN FEES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will amend the fees for use of The Woodland and Burgdorff Center for Performing Arts within the Township of Maplewood.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee's Recreation and Human Services Committee (the "Committee") has reviewed the rates presently being charged at The Woodland and the Burgdorff Center for Performing Arts ("Burgdorff Center"); and,

WHEREAS, the Committee recommended certain changes with regard to User Fees at these facilities; and

WHEREAS, the recommendations of the Committee are beneficial for the residents of the Township of Maplewood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that the following rates be adopted for The Woodland and the Burgdorff Center for Performing Arts:

11. Cancellations made within thirty (30) days prior to the rental date shall only be eligible to receive 25 percent refund of the rental fee.
12. Rentals of both the Theater and Community Room receive a 10% discount for the Community Room.

TO ANNUALLY APPOINT
OFFICERS FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will require that various Township Volunteer Committees annually elect officers from among its membership.

WHEREAS, a review of various Township Ordinances and Township Code Sections, reveals that certain Volunteer Committees are not required to appoint officers from among committee members; and

WHEREAS, the efficient operation of Township Volunteer Committees would be better served by having officers elected annually for each committee; and

WHEREAS, the Maplewood Township Committee would like consistency among its Volunteer Committees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The various Code Sections of the Township of Maplewood shall be amended to read as follows:

FIRST:

Alliance Committee

' 10-6 Organization; bylaws; meetings; minutes.

The Maplewood Township Alliance shall elect its own officers from among its members on an annual basis, establish its own bylaws and meet regularly in accord with the calendar of meetings

to be established by it on a yearly basis. It shall keep minutes of its meetings, and a copy of each set of said minutes shall, after approval of the same, be filed with the Township Clerk.

Green Team

§ 40-3 Membership; term of office; volunteers; reporting.

A. The Maplewood Township Committee shall appoint 11 Township residents to serve as the Green Team. The Green Team shall elect from among its members a Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary/Treasurer on an annual basis. All membership terms shall be for three years. Additionally, a member of the Township Committee shall serve as an ex officio member of the Green Team. The ex officio member shall not vote.

Maplewood Arts Council

§ 44-4 Meetings; Chairperson.

The MAC shall meet at least once each year and shall elect from among its members a Chairperson and other officers as it deems necessary on an annual basis.

Open Space Trust Fund Advisory Committee

§ 47-4 Membership; appointment.

C. The Open Space Trust Fund Advisory Committee shall elect from among its voting members a Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary/Treasurer on an annual basis.

Recreation Advisory Committee

§ 6-25 Recreation Advisory Committee.

Within the Department of Recreation and Cultural Affairs there shall be an Advisory Committee on Recreation to be known as the "Maplewood Recreation Advisory Committee" ("Committee"), which shall consist of nine members. The Committee shall be appointed by the Township Committee from the citizenry of Township. Each appointment shall be for a term of three years on a staggered basis. Each member shall serve without compensation during his/her term. In the event of a vacancy, the Township Committee shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term. There shall be a Chair and Vice Chair of the Committee, each of whom shall be elected on an annual basis by the Committee from the voting membership of the Committee. The Committee shall meet at least once per month and at such other times at such special meetings as may be called by the Chair or Vice Chair in the Chair's absence. The following persons shall be ex officio members of the Committee:

A.

The Director of Recreation and Cultural Affairs or his/her assistant.

B.

A member of the Township Committee.

C.

A representative of the South Orange/Maplewood School Board of Education.

Pool Advisory Committee

§ 49-4 Chair and Vice-Chair.

The Pool Advisory Committee shall select a Chair and Vice-Chair from among its voting members on an annual basis. The Chair shall be responsible for the scheduling and conducting of meetings of the Pool Advisory Committee and for reporting to the Township Committee.

Environmental Advisory Committee

§ 53-5 Governance.

A.

The Maplewood Environmental Advisory Committee shall annually elect a Chair from among its members who shall be responsible for scheduling and conducting meetings of the Committee. The Chair shall serve for one year. Ex officio members may not serve as the Chair.

Seniors Advisory Committee

§ 59-4 Membership; term of office.

D. The Maplewood Seniors Advisory Committee shall elect a Chair and Vice-Chair from among its voting members on an annual basis.

Historic Preservation Commission

§ 271-77 Membership; alternates; compensation; terms; procedures; budget.

F. Procedures. The Commission shall adopt internal rules and procedures for the transaction of its business, subject to the following:

(1)

The Commission shall elect from its members a Chair and a Vice Chair on an annual basis.

(2)

A quorum for the transaction of all business shall be four members.

(3)

All Commission minutes and records are public records, and all Commission meetings shall comply with the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-7 et seq.

(4)

The Commission may designate or elect a Secretary, who need not be a member of the Commission. The Commission shall keep minutes and records of all meetings and proceedings, including voting records, attendance, resolutions, findings, determinations and decisions. All such material shall be made public record.

(5)

Commission meetings shall be scheduled at least once every month or as often as required to fulfill its obligations.

(6)

No Commission member shall be permitted to act on any matter in which he or she has either directly or indirectly any personal or financial interest.

Rent Leveling Board

§ 209-1 Membership of Board.

A.

There is constituted a Rent Leveling Board (Board) within the Township of Maplewood. The Board shall consist of five members and two alternates, who shall sit in place of any absent members. The Township Committee shall appoint each member of the Board and any alternate. Each member of the Board and any alternate shall have a term of office for a period of two years and shall serve without compensation. The Board shall elect a Chair from among its members on an annual basis.

All other Code Sections shall remain unchanged.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

**AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 257
OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
Entitled
"Vehicles and Traffic"**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will establish a "No Parking Here To Corner" zone on Indiana Street at its intersection with Springfield Avenue.

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department of the Township of Maplewood ("Township") has recommended that a "No Parking" zone be created on Indiana Street near its intersection with Springfield Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of this recommendation is deemed to be in the best interests of the residents of Maplewood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-49 shall be amended by adding the following:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Indiana Street	West	From the intersection of Springfield Avenue to a point 95 feet south thereof.

Signage shall be installed indicating "No Parking Here To Corner".

All other sections shall remain unchanged.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph,

subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on May 2, 2017, and that the Township Committee met again on May 16, 2017, at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Township Committee held a hearing and proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on final reading and final passage.
