**AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 123
OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"FEES"
(Municipal Pool)**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will increase the Maplewood Municipal Pool fees.

WHEREAS, the Department of Recreation and Cultural Affairs has recommended a new fee schedule for the Maplewood Community Pool; and

WHEREAS, that recommendation has been reviewed and endorsed by the Maplewood Community Pool Advisory Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

FIRST: Chapter 123 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "General Fees" shall be amended as follows:

Chapter 193, Parks and Recreation Areas

A. Article II, Maplewood Community Pool.

(1) The following fees shall be charged for membership in the community pool commencing with the 2006 Season:

(a) Schedule of Fees.

*Any pool member who has reached the age of 65 by July 1 of the current pool year shall be granted a credit of \$20.00, as reflected above, against his/her pool membership fee upon furnishing satisfactory proof of age, in person, to the Township Clerk at the time of application for membership.

(b) Waiting list, limited family membership, husband, wife and children: \$160 per season

(c) Waiting list, limited individual membership: \$70.00 per season

(2) Fees are not refundable for any reason after the opening of each session.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication according to law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on February 7, 2006 and that Committee met again on February 21, 2006, at 8:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
